





# **ELCHK Kwai Shing Lutheran Primary School Feedback from the principal & teachers**

The participating seed teachers have expressed that the curriculum of the program broadens their horizons. Initially, they had no knowledge of programming instruction, but through the program, they have mastered the principles and techniques involved. They have even transitioned from learners to instructors, experiencing significant changes and a boost in their teaching confidence. The students, who had no prior knowledge of programming, have progressed to creating various small experiments. They have developed a strong interest in learning and eagerly look forward to classes every week. The program has successfully provided a fertile ground for the school, promoting the long-term development of STEAM education. The end-of-term Roadshow is anticipated to showcase the students' learning achievements.



Today's teaching is no longer a one-person show for teachers. The focus is on making students the masters of their own learning. The Thunkable Seed Teacher Training Program allows students to once again experience the interest and joy of learning new things, while also assisting in the promotion of STEAM education in schools. The Thunkable curriculum can be considered challenging, but we have seen students' enthusiasm for Thunkable, with them eagerly asking, "Do we have a class this week?" We have also witnessed students' learning abilities in the course, sometimes surpassing those of adults!
